

## Nevada Department Of Motor Vehicles **DASH PASS Program**

Often times I thought getting a root canal was less painful than going to the DMV. The Nevada DMV has recently joined the twenty first century. You can now get a appointment at any local office of the DMV by using your smart phone and a new process called "**DASH PASS**".

Here's how it works. You can now enter the DMV Queue (line) from your home. There are 3 ways to do this.

1. You can send a text message to the DMV from your smart phone
2. You can call the number listed for each office and get in line.
3. Use your home computer to get a position in the Queue

When you do this it will send a text message back to your smart phone telling you how long in minutes the Queue is. In my recent case the line was 109 minutes long. Which is OK since I didn't have to leave my house until about 50 minutes to go. There is a time update every 30 minutes. (I'm about 30 minutes away from the Henderson Office on Stephanie St.). On the way there, as I hit 30 minutes out from the DMV, the system texted me if I needed additional time in the Queue. If I did, I would simply text the letter "M" back and they would assign me additional time. This is great if you get stuck in traffic. I could also "LEAVE" the line simply texting the letter "L" back to them. Even though the line was 109 minutes long when I entered the Queue from my home I arrived and waited only 15 to 20 minutes until my number was called.
